The Club again had a number of absentees, but we did manage to complete four women's and six men's teams in the open event. Our under 18 men had a good result as did both our under 14 teams.

It was great to two runners back with us today. **Norval Hope** had his first run for the season and **Ailsa Buckle** had her first run for about four years after a stint overseas and a decision to get her schooling out of the way.

The 'Flying Kiwi', **Michael Whitehead** was our first home in the men's event in a very smart time while **Virginia Moloney** grabbed a tremendous sixth placing in the women's championship. The consistent **Erchana Murray-Bartlett** finished 13th and these placings gave us the basis for a good result in the team's event even with a couple missing. Although the men were bad hit by absences, it must be noted that **Liam Delany** and **Jai Edmonds** both ran despite being less than well. Relative newcomer **Hugh McCarthy** was our second finisher in Divvy 1, with a very promising run.

Matthew Newton grabbed 8th spot in the under 18 event, just three notches in front of **Jesse Frost**. Big improver **Tom Hall** rounded out the team in 16th place. **Jack Sayer** had his best run of the season in the 16s while the under 14 boys gained on the ladder leaders with their win in the team's event. The girls in the same age group also picked up a point on their ladder leader but will need a miracle to make up difference in points with only two events to go.
