Steve Griffiths also noted that due to COVID-19 restrictions the Club had been unable to hold the 100 yards championship, and hence the honour board will be notated as 'Not Conducted', which will be a first for the Club.

Election of Office Bearers / Committee

Mr Hopkins confirmed his retirement from the position of the Club's president. He thanked the Committee and members for their support.

He declared all Committee positions vacant, and confirmed that the election for Committee positions had been held via OpaVote to meet the circumstances caused by COVID-19 restrictions. He thanked Campbell Maffett and Michael Oke for suggesting OpaVote as a technology to allow the election to proceed.

He advised that the Committee had appointed Ms Deb Lewis as the returning officer for the election. Ms Lewis then advised the meeting that she is an employee with the Aust. Electoral Commission and Vic. Electoral Commission. She noted her impartiality and said that she had verified the email addresses for the Club's members eligible to vote. It was also noted by Ms Lewis and Mr Hopkins that there were 219 members eligible to vote and that 205 had voted. In addition there were 55 life members eligible to vote, and most had voted.

a. This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared for use by directors and members of the company. The directors have determined that the company is not a reporting entity.

The financial report is prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this report:

b. Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, plant and equipment are carried at cost, independent or directors' valuation. All assets, excluding freehold land and buildings, are depreciated over their useful lives to the company.

c. Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Costs are assigned on a first-in first-out basis and include direct materials, direct labour and an appropriate proportion of variable and fixed overhead expenses.
